Ansaldo STS is awarded a railway signalling contract in Greece

- **Contract is worth EUR 25 Million**
- **Train safety will be increased in the network**

Ansaldo STS, through its Italian subsidiary Ansaldo Segnalamento Ferroviario, has been awarded a contract by Erga-Ose, the Greek Rail Entity, for the supply and commissioning of a Train Control and Management System that will be installed on board 178 train sets.

The contract, for a duration of 3 years, is worth EUR 25 Million.

The contract refers to the design, supply and installation of ETCS level 1 (European Train Control System) on-board equipment. ETCS level 1 allows constant data exchange between the on-board computer system and the Train Control Centres, guaranteeing a better and safer performance of the traffic along the network.

This is the first time ETCS level 1 is being installed on board trains belonging to the Greek Rail Entity, representing an important opportunity for Ansaldo STS to further contribute in future railway projects in the country.

This contract has been awarded also thanks to the long and consolidated experience acquired by Ansaldo STS in supplying this system to RFI in Italy.

This contract follows the recent win of the Thessaloniki driverless metro awarded last year to Ansaldo STS, reinforces the penetration of the company in new markets and further reconfirms the company's unrivalled leadership in the worldwide signalling market.
